The Next level E-series is a fun racing series, with talented and competitive drivers. Your primary goal, as a Team and a Driver, should always be to drive cleanly and safely while on track. All participants should strive to act professionally and demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times. We consider this to be mitigating misconduct on track, in chat, in the Discord Server or anywhere else. Derogatory, offensive or otherwise inappropriate language is prohibited in all communication forums; Race Control reserves the right to evaluate potential problems on a contextual basis.

Series Organizers reserve the right to change the regulations before and during the season. These changes will be communicated in the Discord Server.

Fuel limit: 60% No

Tyre Limit

If you have crashed and there is a lot of damage you need to tow straight away! If not and any accidents happen, penalties might be given.

Practice: 1 hour and 10 min

Qualifying: 20 min, Open Qualifying

Race 1 : 25 min

Intermission : 10 Min

Race 2 : 45 min

Information

During all times make sure you check your e-mail or the Next Level E-Series discord channel for updates or changes.

Voice Chat

Voice chat in game is not allowed, No unnecessary and/or hateful messages to any other driver. This is reportable and will result in a 20s penalty. If hateful enough, the penalty may be more severe - up to the decision of Race control / Admins. We prefer that you will use the team chat in discord during the race when you are with multiple drivers on the same team.



Free Practice Sessions

The organizers host sessions 1 day before the race to practice, more info in our Discord channel

All times CET (Amsterdam) sessions will be open for 4h.

Sunday 19:30

Startgrid Race 1 will be the result from the qualifying

Startgrid Race 2 will be the result from race 1, but with top 10 reversed

Race Session

Session will start at 20:15 CET(Amsterdam)

Sim Time and Conditions

Date and Time of Day same day as the date of the race, time will be at 14:00

Dynamic Weather

Starting Track State for all Sessions

Mirrors time and day of event

Car Classes

Our Series will be a GT3 based championship with all GT3 cars except the Ford GT.

Carnumbers

Pro drivers use carnumbers from 0-99

AM drivers use carnumbers from 100-199

iRating & Safety Rating

iRating: All drivers must have an iRating of 1500 or higher

Safety Rating: All drivers must have at least D 4.0 to be able to participate.

Stewarding

There will be stewarding after the race

Incident Reporting

A report form will be available. These will require the timestamp in iRacing which our Admins/Stewards will then review post-race.

This system will be primarily used to identify intentional and/or malicious incidents, however there is a host of penalties that can be applied, which you can find below.

The report form for an incident has to be filled in before 24:00 CET on the same evening as the race.

Steward Penalties

Custom rules/penalties:

- Incorrect Car Number or Team ID
- Incorrect Driver Rated Line up

These custom penalties will lead into a drive-through penalty added to your total race time after the race.

3 Warnings for a driver in the same race will automatically result in a Drive-Through Penalty iRacing's Sporting Code is in effect and will cover any other issues. We hope this will be enough to keep racing mostly sensible.

Driver-through penalties will be turned into 20s penalties.

Penalty Points

By 3 penalty points a driver will be disqualified for the next event.

Warning

The Penalty Points of each driver will be updated as incidents are reported and analyzed in Discord.

Infraction	Penalty	Penalty point
Going before green	Drive-through penalty	1 point
Failing to maintain a steady speed leading (or in the pack) to the start of race	Drive-through penalty	1 point
Dive-bombing	Steward discretion	1 point
Dangerous driving	Steward discretion	1 point
Intentional wrecking	Driver will be removed from the event	3 points
Intentional blocking	Steward discretion	1 point
Unsafe track rejoin	Steward discretion	1 point
Causing an accident	Steward discretion	1 point

Excessive headlight flashing	First offence: warning Second offence: Drivethrough penalty	1 point
Using in game voice chat	First offence: warning Second offence: Drivethrough penalty	1 point
Ignoring blue flag when being lapped	Steward discretion	1 point

Starting procedure

The start will be the following:

- Leader keeps the pace make sure you keep a steady pace between 60 & 80 km/h.
- Start only goes when iRacing gives a green light. If you go earlier then that penalties will be applied after the race.

Live Broadcasting

All the races will be broadcasted live by our partner Backfire SimSport TV. The livestream links will be shared at each night of the events in our discord in the following channel: "Streaming-Links"
Interviews will be held after the race. It will be mandatory for the top three of the race to get into the discord channel of Next Level E-Series so the interviews can take place. The broadcaster will drag you into the commentary booth

Entry Fee

The entry fee for each driver will be €20,- that can be payed via PayPal. The entry fee will be used to host the sessions and pay the Broadcast fee.

Each driver has 1 scrap result which means that your worst result won't count in the final standings.

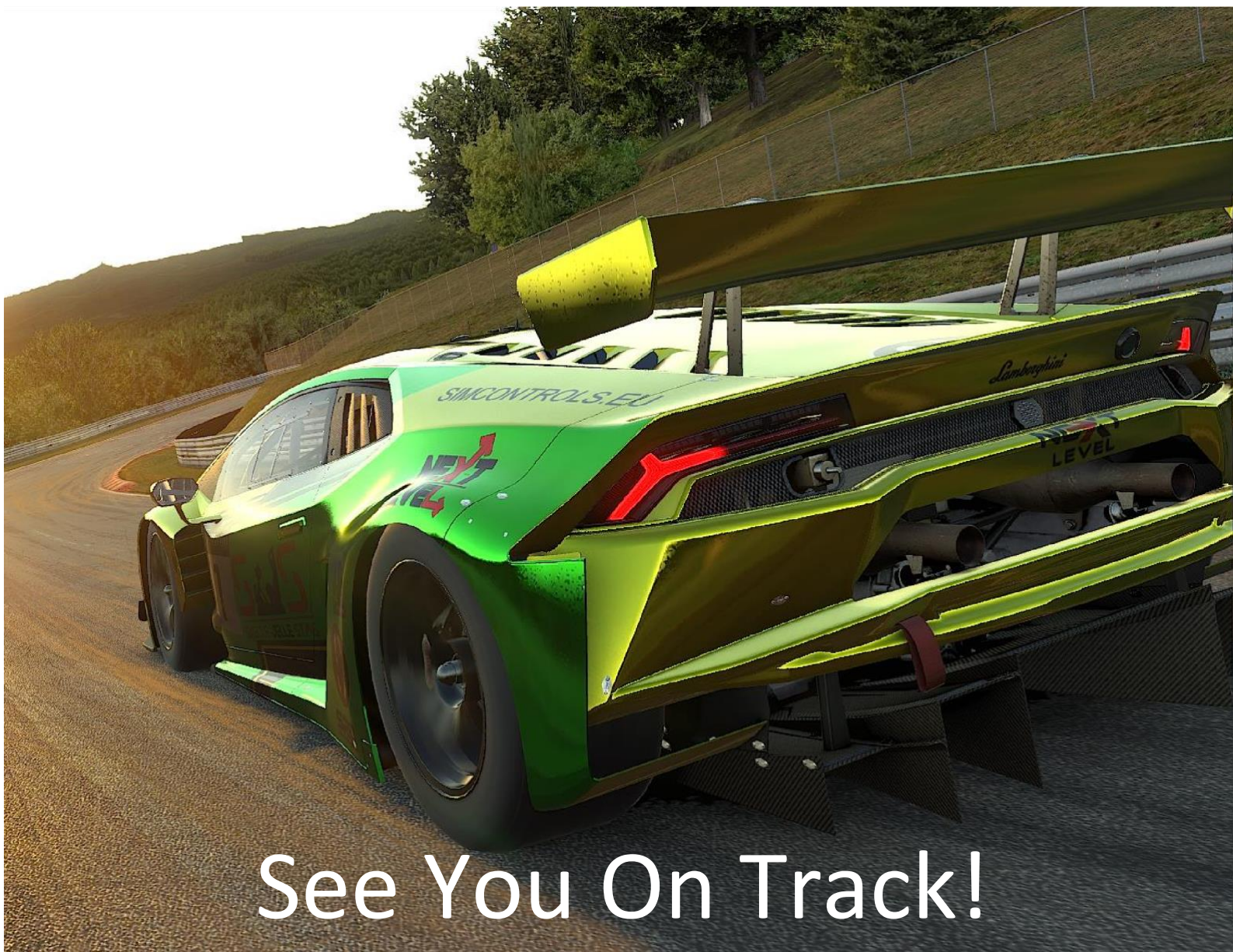
Point system
